



Release and Waiver of Liability
Please Read Carefully

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release"), executed on this ___ day of ___, 20__ by _____.

In favor of Indian River County Habitat for Humanity, Inc., a nonprofit corporation ("Habitat"), its directors, officers, employees and agents the nonprofit's umbrella organization, Habitat for Humanity International. If the Volunteer is under the age of 18, the legal guardian of the Volunteer agrees to all the terms and provisions set forth below on behalf of the Volunteer.

The Volunteer desires to participate and work in Habitat's home building program, and any activities related to the work. The Volunteer understands that the activities may include constructing and rehabilitating residential buildings, being transported to and from work locations, and consuming food and living in accommodations donated for the work.

The Volunteer voluntarily executes this Release under the following terms:

- 1. Waiver and Release. Volunteer releases and holds harmless Habitat and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's participation in Habitat's home building program.
2. Medical Treatment. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's participation in Habitat's home building program.
3. Assumption of the Risk. The Volunteer understands that the participation in Habitat's home building program may include activities that may be hazardous to the Volunteer and that the food, accommodations, and medical facilities may be donated to Habitat and beyond the control of Habitat.
4. Insurance. The Volunteer understands that Habitat is not obligated to carry insurance or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer.
5. Photographic Release. Volunteer does hereby grant and convey unto Habitat all right, title and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by Habitat during Habitat's home building program, including but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.
6. Other. Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Florida, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.
