Attire for Ladies:

- ❖ Dressy pants and shirt or pantsuit
- ❖ Dress shoes
- ❖ No backless or bare midriff dresses.
- ❖ All clothing should be of an appropriate fit, not too tight or overly baggy

Attire for Gentlemen:

- ❖ Tie or bowtie
- ❖ Dress or chino style pants
- ❖ Belt
- ❖ Socks
- ❖ Dress/loafer shoes
- ❖ All clothing should be of appropriate fit, not too tight or overly baggy
