Character Formation

At John Carroll, we believe that character is shaped not only in the classroom, but through the experiences that challenge students to lead, collaborate, and grow. With 75% of our students participating in at least one sport, and over 20 student-led clubs and organizations, there is truly a place for everyone to get involved and belong.



Guided By Catholic Faith

At John Carroll, we are committed to educating the whole child—spiritually, academically, physically, and emotionally—with special emphasis on faith formation. Students grow spiritually through daily religion classes, prayer services, weekly Liturgies of the Word, and over 15 all-school Masses each year. With more than 75% of families belonging to local Catholic parishes, we nurture students’ faith while also sharing the richness of Catholic tradition with those of other beliefs.

Director of Campus Ministry Joshua Kimmelman ’19 reflects: “There’s no doubt that my return to John Carroll is the work of the Holy Spirit. Walking with students as they develop a relationship with the risen Christ is a great gift and a greater aid in my own spiritual life.”

ATHLETICS

Athletics at John Carroll continue to shape students into leaders who compete with heart, integrity, and resilience. This year, our student-athletes excelled across a wide range of sports, with several teams earning district titles, including football, girls basketball, baseball, and flag football. Girls Cross Country and three swimmers advanced to the state championships, and two boys qualified for the state weightlifting meet, including a regional champion. Boys and girls soccer reached the regional finals, and we proudly introduced our girls lacrosse team. Beyond the scoreboard, nine student-athletes signed to play at the collegiate level, demonstrating the strength of our programs and the commitment of our coaches. Whether in victory or in training, our athletes continue to represent John Carroll with pride, discipline, and purpose.

STUDENT LIFE

Clubs continue to be meaningful outlets for students to discover and develop their God-given talents. This year, we proudly launched two new organizations: Future Business Leaders of America and Key Club. FBLA hit the ground running by hosting a schoolwide career fair, opening the Rams Snack Shack, and attending the FBLA Florida State Leadership Conference. Through clubs like FBLA, students are not only learning practical skills but also building confidence, initiative, and a deeper sense of purpose. With more than 20 active clubs, John Carroll students are leading, creating, and serving in ways that reflect their faith and character. As our new Assistant Principal of Student Life, Mrs. Kirsten James ’09, shared, “Our students have the opportunity to explore their interests, build friendships, and grow as leaders. At John Carroll, our clubs are more than just activities, they are a fun and meaningful way for our students to grow into the people that God is calling them to be.”

KAIROS RETREAT

Now in its second year, the Kairos retreat has quickly become a defining moment in the senior year at John Carroll. All seniors are required to attend the four-day, off-campus retreat, which offers a rare and valuable opportunity to disconnect from daily distractions (including their phones) and reconnect with themselves, each other, and God. The time away invites honest conversations, quiet reflection, and a deeper sense of purpose as students prepare for life beyond high school.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In August 2024, John Carroll introduced a weekly Liturgy of the Word. Each Thursday, the school gathers to hear the upcoming Sunday Gospel and a student-led reflection. These reflections, offered by volunteers from all grade levels, help students deepen their understanding of Scripture and grow in confidence as faith leaders.

COMMITMENT TO SERVICE

At John Carroll, service is more than a requirement; it’s a way of life. Guided by Campus Ministry, teachers, and club leaders, students lead projects that reflect their values and passions. This year, efforts included volunteering at Watercrest Assisted Living, making rosaries and blankets, donating diapers, and collecting over 200 jars of peanut butter for Grace Packs.

COURTYARD

In the summer of 2024, we began revitalizing the heart of our campus: our courtyard. The upgrades included installing turf, removing the outdated wooden stage, and adding new picnic tables and umbrellas to create a more welcoming and versatile space for our students. Now, during lunch and after school, the courtyard buzzes with activity as students play spikeball, practice their short game on the new putting greens, and soak up the sunshine together.

GYMNASIUM

Through the generous contributions of our gala donors, John Carroll High School has successfully completed comprehensive renovations to the gymnasium facility. The project encompassed the installation of new bleachers, complete interior painting, and professional epoxy coating of all stairways to enhance both safety and aesthetic appeal.

These strategic improvements have provided our student-athletes with a modernized athletic facility that supports competitive excellence and community engagement. The renovated gymnasium now serves as a premier venue that reflects our institution's commitment to providing exceptional facilities for our students and the broader school community.

FIELD HOUSE

What began as a metal warehouse building originally conceived several years ago has transformed into a 6,000 square foot concrete block structure which includes a state-of-the-art weight room, 2500 square feet of practice turf for speed and agility training, and an indoor concession stand, ticketing window, and restrooms for the athletic complex. Construction for our athletic field house is on track to be completed in early fall of 2025.

GYM BATHROOMS

Thanks to the incredible generosity of our community at the Blue and Gold Gala, we raised \$100,000 to completely renovate the original gymnasium bathrooms, which is an upgrade long overdue. Construction began in May, marking the start of a transformation that will bring these high-traffic facilities up to the standard our students and guests deserve.

This project is a powerful example of how our community comes together to support meaningful improvements across campus.

Elizabeth Dungey Alcalde '92, a member of John Carroll's School Advisory Council, is a nationally recognized employee benefits attorney and Harvard Law graduate. A leader at Akerman LLP, Beth serves on the firm's Executive Committee and Board of Directors, and has previously held key roles such as Chair of Professional Development and Office Managing Partner for Palm Beach County. A proud member of the Class of 1992, Beth and her husband are John Carroll alumni raising their three kids, including the next generation of Rams: Grant, a 2024 graduate, and Clayton, who begins his journey at John Carroll this fall.

As Clayton begins his journey at JCHS this fall, Beth looks forward to seeing him grow in a community where, she notes, “the administration and teachers are phenomenal, the focus on faith is unwavering, and the kindness and generosity of the students is evident. I choose to support John Carroll because the school has enhanced my family's happiness, health, and success.”

We are proud to feature Beth in this year's Impact Report and thankful for the wisdom, heart, and perspective she brings to our community. Her story is a beautiful reminder of the lifelong impact of a John Carroll education and the bright future that continues to unfold through the dedication of alumni, parents, and leaders like her.

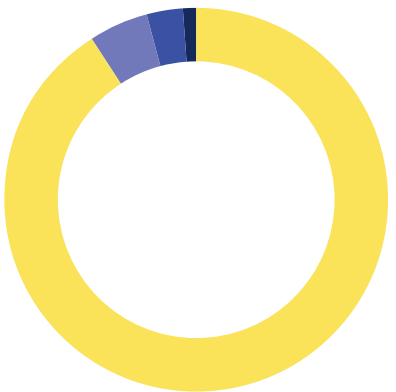
TAXABLE IRA

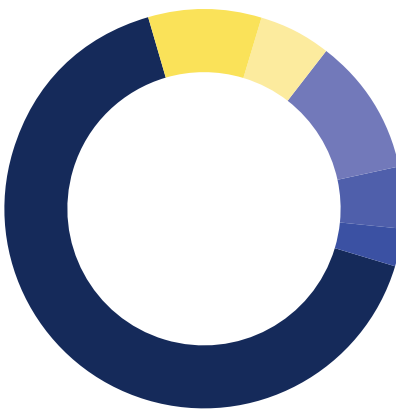
