Dear Parents and Guardians,

We recently received a reminder from the St. Lucie County Department of Public Safety and Communications regarding emergency planning for the nuclear power plant. We would like to inform you about evacuation procedures in the event that an emergency occurs at the St. Lucie Nuclear Power Plant located on Hutchinson Island.

As a precaution, the evacuation of schools may be considered prior to any general public action. Not all schools will require evacuation. Alert information comes to us over our NOAA weather radio system, which is located in the main office. Parents are not to go to schools to pick up children. St. Lucie County Public Safety & Communications, in coordination with the school district, will issue press releases to local radio and television stations announcing when you may pick up your child or children. The pickup location is the St. Lucie County Fairgrounds, 15601 West Midway Road in Fort Pierce.
