

Hello AP World History Students,

I hope you are resting this summer and ready for the first challenge of your high school career. I am so excited that you have chosen to take on this adventure! Get ready to work hard in and outside of school, but first here is a light summer assignment to get your feet wet. This will be due as soon as we return to school for a grade.

1.) Purchase the *Amsco Modern World History* book (ISBN #1531129161). It is a blue book with a ship on the front, and I have included a picture of it below. Make sure it's the new, modern version (1200-present).

- ❖ Available on Amazon (see cover photo at bottom of page)
- ❖ Put your name in Sharpie on the front.
- ❖ Read and hand write neat notes by summarizing important notes from the Prologue, Introduction, and Unit 1 (sections 1.1-1.7). Be sure to label the different parts as Prologue, Intro, 1.1, 1.2, etc. You may use bullet points to separate the notes.
- ❖ Complete the vocabulary: Define the key terms at the end of sections 1.1-1.6 on a sheet of notebook paper, labeled with your name.
- ❖ Section questions: Answer the three multiple choice questions at the end of each section for 1.1-1.6, also on a sheet of notebook paper labeled with your name. Do not complete the short answer questions or writing.

2.) Watch five Unit 0 and Unit 1 videos from the king himself, Steve Heimler. If you don't know him yet, you will soon enough!

- ❖ YouTube Heimler's History (AP World History Review Unit 0): There are two videos.
- ❖ You will also watch at least three videos from AP World History Review Unit 1.
- ❖ You'll need to label the video titles and neatly hand write notes from the videos on a piece of paper from at least five videos.


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
